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TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Handicap will be based on 90% from 690 scratch for the trio team. Handicap entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league yearbook or association average based on a minimum of 21 game for the 2007-2008 season, unless Jan 01, 2009 is ten (10) pins or more higher (USBC Rule 319a). If no average last year, use highest current USBC sanctioned average, 21 games or more, as of January 1, 2009. If you do not have an average that qualifies you to bowl, you may use your highest current sanctioned league average, 21 games or more as of date of bowling. If you do not have an average that qualifies you to bowl, you may use your highest sanctioned summer league average for the 2008 summer season. All others bowl scratch. See USBC Rule 319a.
2. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average in handicap tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher, per USBC Rule 319a. Entrants who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any event in a tournament within the 12-month period prior to entry in this tournament must report their actual score, position and amount won to the tournament manager for possible re-rating, per USBC Rule 319d.
3. A bowler shall adjust such entering average, and shall submit the adjusted average to the tournament manager, if during the 12-month period immediately preceding the date of bowling his accumulated average in all but not less than 21 tournament games exceeds such entering average by 15 or more pins. Bowlers required to submit an adjusted average will make the adjustment in keeping with the direction of USBC Rule 319e.
4. The tournament manager or his designated representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling. Such adjustment may be appealed to USBC within fifteen (15) days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. If, due to the adjustment, the entrant chooses not to bowl, the entry fee shall be refunded.
5. Entry fee: \$60.00 per team (Prize fund \$30.00, Bowling Fee \$27.00, Expense Fee \$3.00 per team). There will be one prize for each five entries. Prize fees will be returned 100%. CCUSBC Championship Shirts will be awarded to Handicap team champions.
6. Entries close 3:30 PM APRIL 26, 2009.
7. Teams may bowl more than once by changing one bowler. There is no limit on the number of times a bowler may participate.
8. All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the tournament manager within 48 hours after the bowler or team has bowled.
9. All participants must be members of USBC and the CCUSBC. Non-USBC members who are residents of Clark County, Washington, may establish eligibility by purchase of an associate membership for \$20.00.
10. Not more than one professional bowler will be allowed to bowl on a Trio team. A professional bowler is defined as a bowler who holds a membership card in the PBA.
11. All teams holding a reservation are requested to check in at the tournament office not later than 20 minutes prior to the scheduled time for bowling.
12. A tournament game or frames(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Manager (see USBC Rule #327c).
13. \$20.00 or actual fee assessed will be charged for any checks returned by Banks, Credit Unions, etc.
14. Scratch Sidepot. For an additional optional fee of \$30.00 per team, (Prize fund \$27.00, Expense fee \$3.00), trio teams may enter the optional scratch (no handicap) sidepot. There will be one prize for each 5 entries in the Scratch Sidepot. Prize fees will be returned 100%.

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
