Handicap: This shall be a CCUSBC sanctioned tournament, in one division, with handicap as follows: 90% from 230 scratch in Singles event, 460 scratch in the Doubles event, and 1150 scratch in the Team event, 3 game format, with Optional Scratch Singles, Handicap & Scratch All Events.

Entering Average: Entrants will use:

- A. Highest USBC 2007-08 sanctioned league average, 21 games or more. **(USBC Rule 319a (2) applies as of 01/01/09 in effect.)**
- B. If no 2007-08 average, entrant may use highest current USBC sanctioned league average, 21 games or more, as of January 1, 2009 (copy of league sheet required).
- C. Summer league averages will be accepted if no yearbook average (copy of league sheet required).
- D. If you do not have an average that qualifies you to bowl, you may use your highest USBC 2008-09 sanctioned league average 21 games or more as of date of entry.
- E. All others bowl scratch.
- F. Verification in the form of a standing sheet or notice from League Secretary is required for other than yearbook averages.

Average Verification: Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Average corrections can be made up to the end of first game of a series. If submitted average is lower and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher, prize winning will be based on the submitted average, per USBC rule 319a.(3). In the case of a team of two or more bowlers, the averages will be combined to determine if the correct total is higher or lower in the submitted total.

\$600 Prize Qualification, Rule 319d: Entrants who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any event in a tournament within a 12 month period prior to entry in this tournament must sort the following information at time of entry for possible re-rating, per USBC rule 319d: (1) The name of each tournament in which he/she has been paid such a prize, or if not yet paid, in which he/she has qualified for the prize; (2) The amount of the prize; (3) The actual score bowled that qualified for the prize, and (4) The prize position.

Average Readjustment: The tournament manager or his designated representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling. If due to adjustment, the entrant chooses not to bowl, his entry fee will be refunded.

Tournament Entry Fees: \$20.00 per person per event, i.e. \$100.00 per 5 person team, \$40.00 per 2 person team (Doubles), \$20.00 per Singles Event. Distribution of the \$20.00 per person/event fees is as follows; \$8.75 Prize Fund, \$9.00 bowling lineage, and \$2.25 expense fee. An entrant may also enter (optionally) Singles event Handicap or Scratch, All Events Scratch &/or Handicap for an additional fee of \$10.00 (prize fund \$9.00 & expense fee \$1.00) per All Event division. No entry fees will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time with intention of Rule 5.

Prizes: There will be one prize for each 5 entries in all events. Prize fees will be returned 100% within each event.

Entry Closing Date: Closing date for entries will be 30 minutes prior to last squad. All entries must be received prior to closing time. Entry fees must accompany the entry. Mail Entry : as to: **CCUSBC 2101 E. Evergreen Blvd. Suite #103 Vancouver, WA 98661.**

Multiple Participation: Unlimited entry in team event by changing two bowlers. Doubles and Singles are unlimited by changing partners in doubles, and Singles may cash all times bowl in **last event in Team, Doubles and Singles will go toward All Events score.**

Errors: All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 48 hours after bowlers or team have participated.

Professional Bowlers: No more than two professional bowlers will be allowed to bowl on a 5 person team event unless they are regular members of the team and have bowled two-thirds of league schedule as of the date of their scheduled appearance. Not more than one professional bowler will be permitted on a doubles team. A professional bowler is defined as a bowler who holds a membership in a Professional Bowlers Association.

Eligibility: All participants must be current members of USBC and the CCUSBC. Non USBC members who are residents of Clark County, WA may bowl in the tournament by paying an associate membership fee of \$20.00

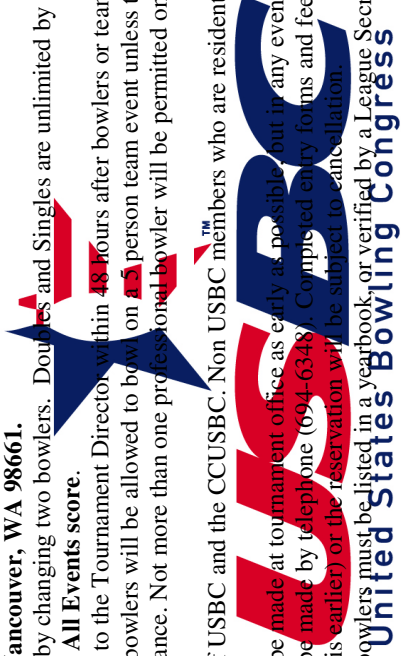
Changes: Changes in the lineups or substitutions must be made at tournament office as early as possible, but in any event no later than 15 minutes prior to start of the squad.

Reservations: Reservations for open squad times may be made by telephone (694-6348). Completed entry forms and fees must be received in the tournament office within 7 calendar days of date of reservation or the entry closing date (whichever is earlier) or the reservation will be subject to cancellation.

Substitute Bowler Averages: Averages for substitute bowlers must be listed in a yearbook, or verified by a League Secretary or a standing sheet, within 3 days or he/she will be entered as scratch bowler.

Returned Checks: All returned checks will be charged a fee of \$25.00 or the actual bank charge, whichever is greater.

CCUSBC Championship Shirts: The winning Team members, Doubles, Singles, and All Event handicap winners will be awarded a Championship shirt from the prize fund. Only one shirt will be awarded for multiple winners. The CCUSBC reserves the right to publish names, photos, and stories of the winners in the Annual Yearbook and other promotional material.
