Clark County USBC Women's Tournament Rules

1. **Dates:** March 21st & 22nd, 28th & 29th of March 2009.
2. Entry is open to **WOMEN MEMBERS OF THE CCUSBC**. **Entries close at 2:30 PM March 29th, 2009.**
3. **AVERAGE:** It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of average.
 - (a) Entrants use their highest book average from the 2007-2008 season, provided they have bowled 21 games or more (substitute averages may be used) in establishments in Clark County WA.
 - (b) If average is 10 pins or more higher than 2007-08 season, as of January 1, 2009, that average is to be used as per Clark County USBC Board of Directors.**
 - (c) If entrant does not have a book average for the 2007-2008 season, she shall use current high league average in the CCUSBC as of January 1, 2009 provided she has bowled 21 games or more. (see Note)
 - (d) If entrant does not qualify under rule a or b, she shall use her highest current average in a CCUSBC sanctioned league for 21 games or more at the time of participation. Averages established in sanctioned summer leagues shall be accepted as official provided the bowler does not have an acceptable regular season average.
 - (e) Any entrant not qualifying under any of the above mentioned categories must enter with a 220 scratch average.

NOTE: An average verification form, dated your last day of bowling prior to submittal of entry, must be provided with entry form if qualifying under rule c. (Verification form is a signed statement or league standing sheet from your league secretary.)
4. **CHECK-IN:** Teams must check in 45 minutes prior to bowling. Current CCUSBC membership will be checked for all of the events bowled. Verification of time scheduled to bowl will be available to the team captain. (If requested times are not available, coordination with team captain will be provided by tournament directors) Non-Members may join as Associate Members for a cost of \$20.00 or pay \$5.00 for a one time event fee membership.
5. **HANDICAP:** Tournament will be handicapped. Handicap will be 90 percent of 220 (no limit) based on individual averages for a three game format:

6. **TEAM EVENT:** Four member teams will bowl three consecutive games on one pair of lanes. Bowlers may participate in team event unlimited times, by changing one member. You may bowl team event without bowling doubles and singles and vice-versa. **DOUBLES/SINGLES:** A bowler may participate in the doubles unlimited, but must change partners, may bowl singles three times and only cash once. **Singles and Doubles will be bowled on separate squads.**
7. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** Are allowed when replacement is necessary. The tournament director should be advised of substitutions at least one hour before scheduled bowling time. Substitutes average form to be provided. If a average of a substitute changes the classification of the event, such event shall be reclassified, and prize list shall be changed. No pacers allowed.
8. Any player or team arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl. No score will be given for frames missed.
9. Entrants must bowl in the order they are listed on the entry form. A sub. shall take place in the lineup of the original entrant. If an emergency arises in the team or doubles event, a sub. may enter the game after it has started and the combined score will count. Handicap will be adjusted accordingly.
10. The handicap team, doubles and singles winners in each division will be awarded a CCUSBC Championship shirt, only one shirt per tournament. If there is a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared with first and second money divided equally and duplicate awards given.
11. **ALL EVENTS:** Optional All Events fees must be paid prior to bowling first event. An All Events entry may be transferred, provided the transfer is made before the bowlers involved have participated in any event of the tournament. There will be an All Events for each division. When an award (excluding cash awards) is provided for the All Events winner, the bowler who places first in All Events shall be entitled to the award if she has paid the optional fee. **When a bowler competes more than once, her first appearance in each event shall count toward her All Events score, which is the total of her team, doubles and singles scores.**
12. Pay off ratio will be 1 for 5 in each division. Pay off ratio for All Events will be 1 for 10 in each division. Prize money will be distributed to team captains within 30 days after the close of the tournament, unless a protest or re-rating occurs. List of winners will be posted in all bowling centers. Prize list will be mailed upon request. **The team captain is responsible for distributing any prize money within 15 days of receipt.**
13. **BOWLING ALONE:** When players are scheduled alone on a pair of lanes they must bowl all games as though they were actually contested. Each entrant must have completed her frame on one lane before the player bowling leadoff commences her next frame on the adjoining lane.
14. The Tournament Managers shall decide any questions not covered by these rules. Any protest concerning errors in scoring must be made to the tournament managers within 24 hours after the score has been bowled. Other protests must be presented in writing to the CCUSBC Board of Directors before the tournament prize payments are made.

15. The entrant whose name appears hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agrees that the CCUSBC, its officers and agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when the entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency, or emergencies of causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other caused beyond the control of the CCUSBC.
